Podium presentations (11.00-12.30)

- There will be **7 MINS for PRESENTATIONS** and then **3 MINS for QUESTIONS**
- Please bring your presentations on a USB stick.
- Marks will be awarded for timekeeping.
- The top scoring presentation on the day will be awarded the Professor Pickard Plate for best paper.

Poster presentations (15.30 – 16.45)

- For this session you need to have brought a poster and put it up at the beginning of NEUS (see poster instructions below)
- There will be **4 MINS for PRESENTATION** and then **3 MINS for QUESTIONS**.
- Please bring with you on a USB stick a power point presentation of **NOT MORE THAN 3 SLIDES** representing the salient points from your poster. Alternatively, you can show a slide of your poster and zoom into relevant points. If you just display the poster on a power point slide it will be difficult for the audience to see it. Zooming in (unless you have the software) could be tricky so 3 SLIDES is likely to be easier.
- You will be held to time and marks will be awarded for timekeeping.
- The top scoring presentation will be awarded the short poster prize.

- Please put them up at the start of the day.
- Please make your posters to A0 size (841 x 1189 mm) and to be in the **PORTRAIT** orientation.
